This document shall amend Contract Assignment Rehab 182 for Rehabilitation Projects (“Agreement”) by and between Lightning Labor Construction Services, LLC, (the “Vendor”) and the State of North Carolina, Department of Public Safety, Office of Recovery and Resiliency (hereinafter referred to individually as “State” or “NCORR”) executed on November 16, 2023.
