AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE (1)

State of North Carolina **Department of Public Safety** NC Office of Recovery and Resiliency (NCORR)

This document shall amend Contract RFB.Informal.MHU 25 for Manufactured Housing Units ("Agreement") by and between Shepherd Response, LLC (the "Vendor") and the State of North Carolina, Department of Public Safety, Office of Recovery and Resiliency (hereinafter referred to individually as "State" or "NCORR") executed on November 29, 2023. All projects awarded under this contract **shall have** all NTP's issued within **80 calendar days** of contract execution (unless requested earlier by GCs). NCORR reserves the right to issue projects Notice to Proceed at any point as determined in the best interest of the program and its applicants.
